## Notice of the preparation of an amendment to a planning scheme

## Amendment C172bany

## Overview

The amendment applies to the Heidelberg Major Activity Centre (MAC) as currently defined in the Banyule Planning Scheme and proposes a range of planning scheme changes, such as applying new and varied zoning schedules, to support the recommendations of the '*Heidelberg Structure Plan, Final* (Banyule City Council, April 2023)'. The amendment also proposes a number of minor corrections to the current application of zones in the Heidelberg MAC.

## Details of the amendment

The Banyule City Council has prepared Amendment C172bany to the Banyule Planning Scheme.

The land affected by the amendment is land within the Heidelberg Major Activity Centre, as currently defined at Clause 11.03-1L-02 (Heidelberg Major Activity Centre) of the Banyule Planning Scheme.

The amendment proposes to implement the *Heidelberg Structure Plan, Final* (Banyule City Council, April 2023) by strengthening the strategic framework for the Heidelberg Major Activity Centre (Heidelberg MAC), removing a section of land from the Heidelberg MAC and applying an Activity Centre Zone (ACZ) and residential zone schedules to the land to be retained in the Heidelberg MAC. In addition, the amendment proposes to make a number of corrections to the application of zones in the Heidelberg MAC, particularly regarding the application of zones that denote land for public uses.

Any person may make a submission to the planning authority about the amendment. Submissions must be made in writing giving the submitter's name and contact address, clearly stating the grounds on which the amendment is supported or opposed and indicating what changes (if any) the submitter wishes to make.

Name and contact details of submitters are required for the planning authority to consider submissions and to notify such persons of the opportunity to attend planning authority meetings and any public hearing held to consider submissions.

The closing date for submissions is Monday 18 March 2024 at 11.59pm. A submission must be provided to the Banyule City Council by one of the following methods:
