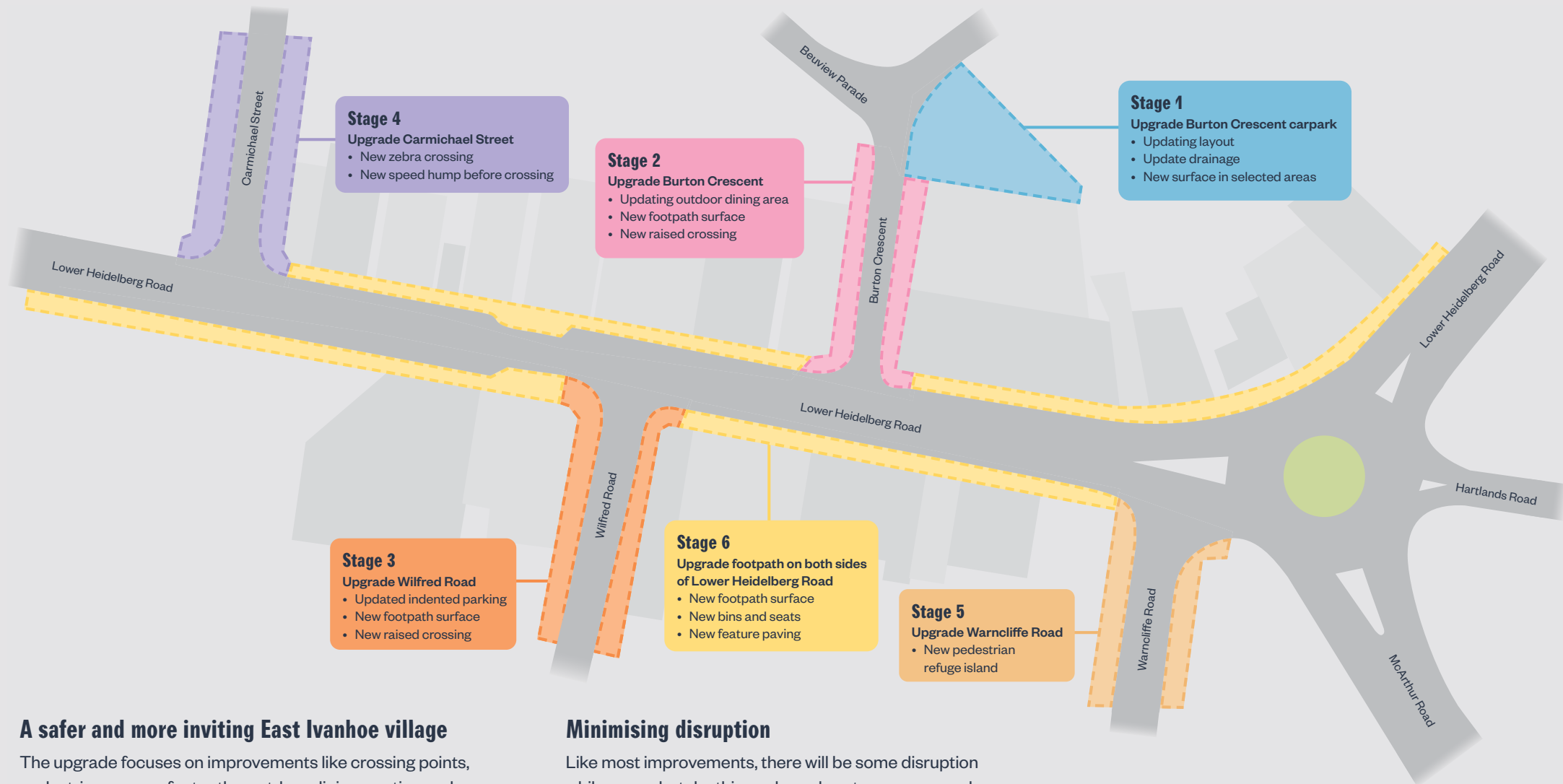

We're upgrading East Ivanhoe shopping village!

Banyule Council is investing in a significant streetscape upgrade for East Ivanhoe shopping village. It will become a safer and more inviting place to shop, meet, connect and celebrate.



East Ivanhoe streetscape upgrade stages – March to December 2024



A safer and more inviting East Ivanhoe village

The upgrade focuses on improvements like crossing points, pedestrian access, footpaths, outdoor dining, seating and greenery and trees. It includes:

- New footpath surfaces within the existing kerbs
- Safer pedestrian crossings at Warncliffe Road, Wilfred Road, Burton Crescent and Carmichael Street
- Seating and other street furniture in keeping with local heritage
- Improved planting and green spaces
- Better drainage for Burton Crescent carpark

Minimising disruption

Like most improvements, there will be some disruption while we undertake this work, such as temporary road and footpath closures.

Parking will be available and pedestrian access will be maintained as much as possible except during the brief periods when new path sections are being laid. We will complete small stages at a time to minimise disruption to residents, shops and business owners.
