



LEGEND

- 1 Existing half court and rebound wall retained and upgraded. Drink fountain and seating areas upgraded.
- 2 Space currently used as an informal nature play area. Further enhance and promote the use of this space in consultation with the community.
- 3 Support the neighbourhood house in the future with its development of a 'welcome' gateway between the community garden and the park.
- 4 Existing equipment and location of play area retained. Establish perimeter ring of shade trees.
- 5 Look at opportunities to recognise heritage value of the hall as well as any broader colonial and indigenous history of the reserve.
- 6 Maintain current informal use of space for dogs while reviewing options for the provision of a formal dog off lead area within the North West Open Space Precinct.
- 7 Existing BBQ retained. Community gathering space upgraded and enhanced with the addition of a new shelter and coordinated range of park furniture.
- 8 Level open grassy space retained for informal recreational use.
- 9 Investigate opportunities for involving the local community in the establishment and monitoring of habitat for native animals. e.g. Sugar gliders.
- 10 Support the incorporation of art, sculpture and mosaic within the future upgrade of the reserve where feasible.

Path Network

The following improvements to the path network have been identified for consideration in the future;

- Path links between the neighbourhood house, the community hall and Lambourn Road.
- Provision of a diagonal path link from Kenmare St through to Lambourn Rd.
- Provision of a path link from Boger Rd to the playground and neighbourhood house.
- Establishment of a hierarchy of path types.

Tree Management

The following tree management works to be investigated and conducted as part of ongoing improvements to the reserve;

- Assessment of all trees in reserve.
- Provision of additional shade trees within playground area.
- Identify any trees of significance to this reserve.
- Provision of mulch areas around indigenous tree stands.

Lighting

The following measures to upgrade lighting along paths to be investigated and assessed as part of ongoing improvements to the reserve;

- The need for additional lighting along path linking Kenmare St. and Boger Rd.
- The requirement for new lighting in connection with the proposed diagonal path between Kenmare St and Lambourn Rd.
